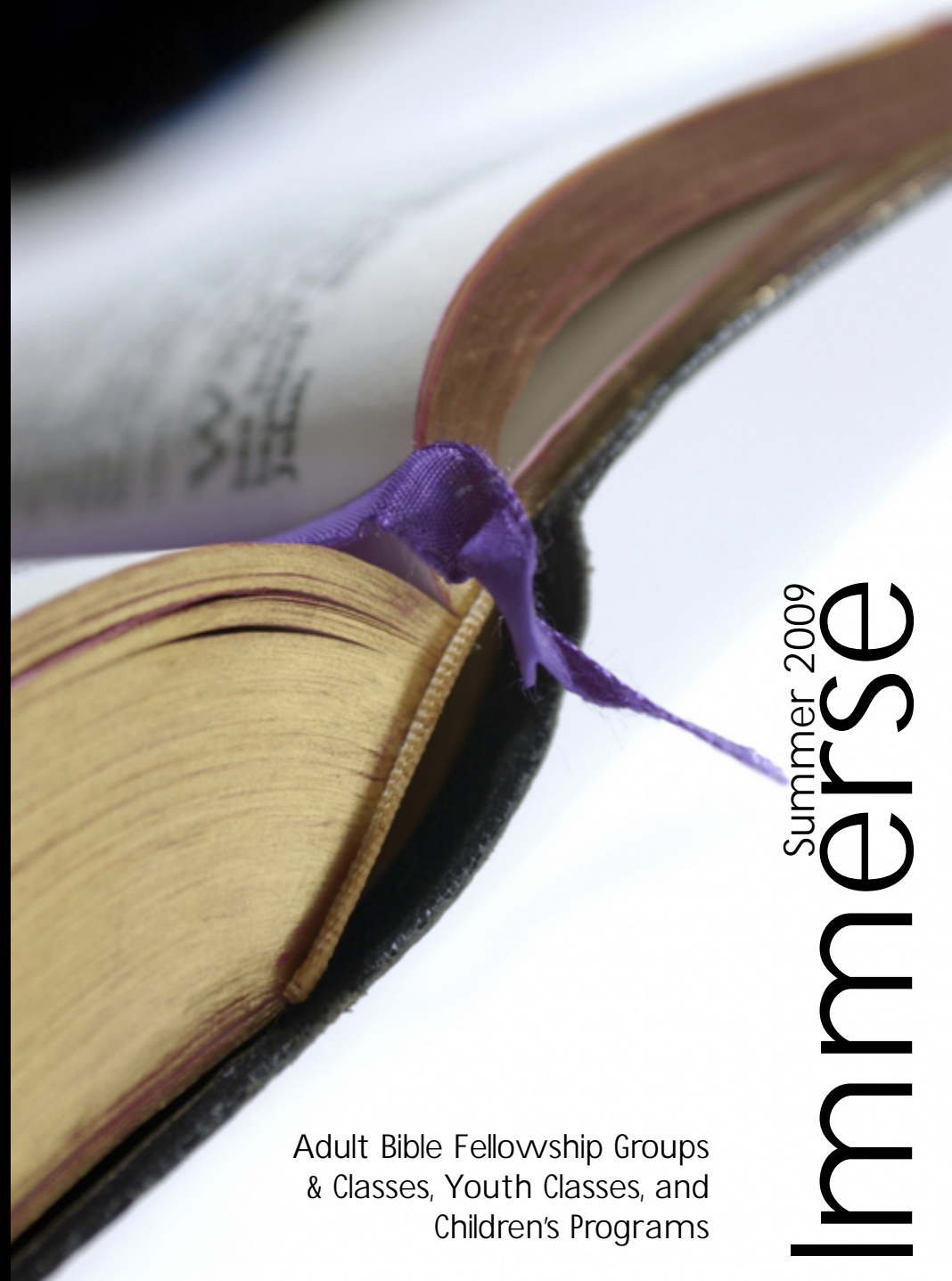

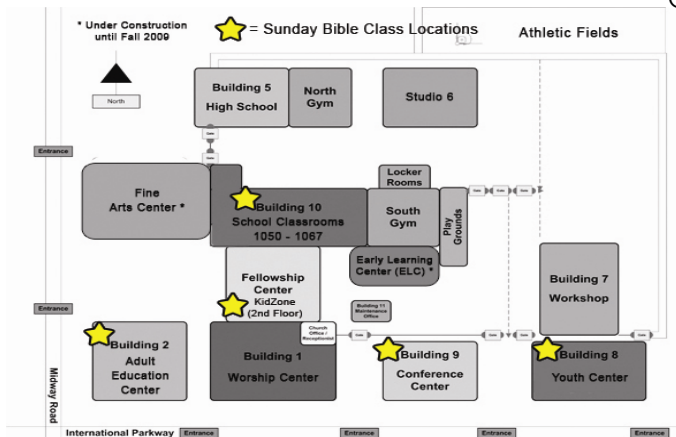

Jesus' parables are powerful, profound, and timeless. Each contains nuances of meaning that can be appreciated fully only when seen through ancient Middle Eastern eyes. This class explores how Jesus' audience would have understood eleven of His parables out of Luke's gospel. In doing so, it draws upon remarkable and historical insights from renowned New Testament scholar, Dr. Kenneth Bailey, who spent 40 years living and teaching in Egypt, Lebanon, Jerusalem, and Cyprus. The materials, group discussion, and memorable graphics combine to help modern-day disciples gain a deeper understanding of the Kingdom Jesus speaks of in the parables.
